They will be seeking legislation at the next Council meeting to be able to begin the engineering process and get ready to go out to bid. At the January 14, 2021, Council approved allowing the Mayor to go out to bid for asphalt and limestone for 2021 to assist in road repairs. GROUP 1A CONSISTS OF:

EMS RESPONDERS AND HEALTH CARE WORKERS
RESIDENTS AND STAFF AT NURSING HOMES
RESIDENTS AND STAFF AT ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES
PEOPLE WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES/MENTAL ILLNESS IN GROUP HOMES

RESIDENTS AND STAFF AT OHIO VETERANS HOMES

This group is currently being vaccinated.

GROUP 1B CONSISTS OF:

OHIOANS AGE 65 AND OLDER THOSE LIVING WITH SEVERE CONGENITAL, DEVELOPMENT OR EARLY-ONSET MEDICAL DISORDERS

This group is being instructed to sign up with the Lake County Health Department and then they will be scheduled as vaccine becomes available.

This system will be one of several resources available for residents to have easy access to the most up-to-date information. Residents are invited to text the keyword LAKEOHVAX to 69310 to sign-up to receive messages from the WENS system. This is an optional service, and residents do not need to sign up for this service to be receive notifications when vaccine is available.

Police in Willoughby Hills investigating after man shot during carjacking at apartment complex

WILLOUGHBY HILLS, Ohio — A 65-year-old man has been hospitalized after police say he was shot during a carjacking at a Willoughby Hills apartment complex.

According to Chief Matthew Naegele, the incident happened just after 7:00 p.m. at the Willoughby Hills Towers on Chardon Road. Police were called to the scene after reports of multiple shots being fired in the parking lot. When officers arrived, they found the victim on the north side parking deck of the apartment complex. He sustained a gunshot wound, which is believed to be non-life threatening. The victim was transported to an area hospital by Willoughby Hills Fire / EMS where he is being treated.

Early reports show that at least two suspects arrived to the apartment complex in a newer model, bright red pickup truck. The victim, who was standing by his own vehicle in the parking lot, was approached by a suspect described as a Black male, early twenties, clean shaven.

The suspect reportedly took out a semi-automatic pistol, assaulted the victim, and then shot him. The suspect then entered the victim's vehicle described as a 2010 black Ford Fusion and fled the scene along with the red pickup truck that the suspects arrived in. The stolen Ford Fusion reportedly struck several vehicles in the parking lot causing front end damage to the Ford.

Both vehicles reportedly fled east on Chardon Road towards the area of Bishop Road and Interstate 90.
