GROUP 1B CONSISTS OF:

OHIOANS AGE 65 AND OLDER THOSE LIVING WITH SEVERE CONGENITAL, DEVELOPMENT OR EARLY-ONSET MEDICAL DISORDERS

This group is being instructed to sign up with the Lake County Health Department and then they will be scheduled as vaccine becomes available.

MORE COVID VACCINE INFORMATION:

To support the response, Lake County is also utilizing the WENS system which has the ability to send out text notifications to update residents about important changes to the LCGHD's COVID-19 Vaccine website, https://www.lcghd.org/2019-novel-coronavirus-ncov/covid-19-vaccination.
This system will be one of several resources available for residents to have easy access to the most up-to-date information. Residents are invited to text the keyword LAKEOHVAX to 69310 to sign-up to receive messages from the WENS system. This is an optional service, and residents do not need to sign up for this service to be receive notifications when vaccine is available.

The Charter Review Commission, consisting of nine residents, have met to discuss the plan to review our current City Charter. Our City Charter is like a blueprint for how the City is run, and who runs it. The Charter document can be found on the City's website.

The Charter Review Commission has planned Public Hearings to give their fellow residents an opportunity to weigh in on amendments they would like to see to the Charter. These meetings are set for Tuesday, February 23 and Wednesday, February 24, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. via Zoom. They will provide residents a chance to speak for up to four (maximum) 7-minute times to convey their thoughts to the Commission.
