SNOW PLOW DAMAGE:

• If the City plow hits a mailbox, we will fix it. Please contact us right away. If the post is rotted & falls over from snow, we will not replace the mailbox or post. This will be determined by the Road Supervisor. It is the resident's responsibility to check their mailbox on an annual basis. Snow plow shields can be installed by the resident.

***CALL US FIRST TO MAKE THE REPAIR/REPLACEMENT OF THE MAILBOX. WE WILL NOT REIMBURSE FOR ANY PURCHASES/REPAIRS THAT ARE DONE BY SOMEONE OTHER THAN THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT.

• Should you have damage to your property from the City plows, please contact us. Some damage can be repaired immediately. Others may require us to put you on our "Spring Clean-up" List. Once topsoil is available, we can do the proper repairs to put your lawn back in place.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING REGISTRATION FOR COVID VACCINE:

How do I get an appointment?

On Friday mornings, vaccine appointments for the following week will be available in ArmorVax. Notice of available appointments will also be posted on the Lake County General Health District website (www.lcghd.org) on LCGHD's Facebook and Twitter accounts, and announced via LCGHD's weekly Situation Report. Lake County residents who currently qualify to receive the COVID-19 vaccine should create an account with the ArmorVax scheduling system by visiting www.armorvax.com. Once an account is created, eligible users will be able to search for available vaccine appointments.

- Important tips for creating an ArmorVax account include the following:
- Use a unique email address for each person creating an account.
- Be certain to select your eligible occupation and/or condition when creating account.
- You must first answer the screening questions before you will be able to schedule an appointment time.
- Do not attempt to create an ArmorVax account until your eligibility is announced you will not be able to schedule an appointment.
- Individual identification and proof of occupation is required for all vaccine appts.

Those without email addresses, and/or needing assistance with making appointments may call (440) 350-2684 on Mondays and Tuesdays, between from 8 am to 4:30 pm.

ONCE YOUR AGE GROUP BECOMES ELIGIBLE, BE SURE TO SIGN UP AND YOU WILL BE SCHEDULED.
