INCOME TAX NEWS:

TAX DAY FOR INDIVIDUALS EXTENDED TO MAY 17, 2021!

THE IRS ANNOUNCED THIS WEEK THAT THE FEDERAL INCOME TAX FILING DUE DATE FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH THE 2020 TAX YEAR WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY EXTENDED FROM APRIL 15, 2021 TO MAY 17, 2021. EVEN WITH THE NEW DEADLINE, IRS URGES TAXPAYES TO CONSIDER FILING AS SOON AS POSSIBLE, ESPECIALLY THOSE WHO ARE OWED REFUNDS. FILING ELECTRONICALLY WITH DIRECT DEPOSIT IS THE QUICKEST WAY TO GET REFUNDS. INDIVIDUAL TAXPAYERS DO NOT NEED TO FILE ANY FORMS OR CALL THE IRS TO QUALIFY FOR THIS AUTOMATIC FEDERAL TAX FILING AND PAYMENT RELIEF.

NEWS FROM MAYOR GARDNER'S OFFICE:

CHANGES COMING TO THE 440 AREA CODE: TEN DIGIT DIALING BEGINS ON APRIL 24, 2021 & WILL BE MANDATORY BY OCTOBER 24, 2021!

THE CITY HAS BEEN MADE AWARE OF A NEW POLICY THAT WILL AFFECT OUR PERSONAL PHONES, EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS, AND OTHER ASPECTS WHEN DIALING ANY NUMBER IN THE 440 AREA CODE.

THE FEDERAL COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION (FCC) HAS ADOPTED "988" AS A NEW THREE-DIGIT NUMBER TO BE USED NATIONWIDE TO REACH THE NATIONAL SUICIDE PREVENTION & MENTAL HEALTH CRISIS LIFELINE, STARTING JULY 16, 2022. IN ORDER FOR "988" TO WORK IN CERTAIN AREA CODES, 10-DIGIT LOCAL DIALING MUST FIRST BE IMPLEMENTED. THE 440 AREA CODE HERE IN OHIO HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS ONE OF THE TWO AREA CODES WHERE YOU WILL NEED TO CHANGE THE WAY YOU DIAL LOCAL CALLS.

WHAT WILL BE THE NEW DIALING PROCEDURE?

TO COMPLETE ALL LOCAL CALLS, YOU WILL NOW NEED TO DIAL AREA CODE + TELEPHONE NUMBER. THIS APPLIES TO ALL CALLS WITHIN OUR 440 AREA CODE THAT ARE CURRENTLY DIALED WITH SEVEN DIGITS.

WHEN WILL THE CHANGE BEGIN?

BEGINNING APRIL 24, 2021, YOU SHOULD BEGIN DIALING 10 DIGITS (AREA CODE + TELEPHONE NUMBER) FOR ALL LOCAL CALLS. IF YOU FORGET AND DIAL JUST 7 DIGITS, YOUR CALL WILL STILL BE COMPLETED.
BEGINNING OCTOBER 24, 2021, YOU MUST DIAL 10-DIGITS (AREA CODE + TELEPHONE NUMBER) FOR ALL LOCAL CALLS. ON & AFTER THIS DATE, LOCAL CALLS WITH ONLY 7 DIGITS MAY NOT BE COMPLETED AND A RECORDING WILL INFORM YOU THAT YOUR CALL CANNOT BE COMPLETED AS DIALED!

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING REGISTRATION FOR COVID VACCINE:

How do I get an appointment?

On Friday mornings, vaccine appointments for the following week will be available in ArmorVax. Notice of available appointments will also be posted on the Lake County General Health District website (www.lcghd.org) on LCGHD's Facebook and Twitter accounts, and announced via LCGHD's weekly Situation Report. Lake County residents who currently qualify to receive the COVID-19 vaccine should create an account with the ArmorVax scheduling system by visiting www.armorvax.com. Once an account is created, eligible users will be able to search for available vaccine appointments.

- Important tips for creating an ArmorVax account include the following:
- Use a unique email address for each person creating an account.
- Be certain to select your eligible occupation and/or condition when creating account.
- You must first answer the screening questions before you will be able to schedule an appointment time.
- Do not attempt to create an ArmorVax account until your eligibility is announced you will not be able to schedule an appointment.
- Individual identification and proof of occupation is required for all vaccine appts.

Those without email addresses, and/or needing assistance with making appointments may call (440) 350-2684 on Mondays and Tuesdays, between from 8 am to 4:30 pm.

CAMPBELL PARK UPDATE

WITH THE RECENT GUIDELINES PUBLISHED BY THE LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AND CDC, THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS HAS ESTABLISHED THE FOLLOWING POLICY UPDATES FOR PARKS & RECREATION:

BASKETBALL COURTS - CLOSED (DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING CONCERNS)

TENNIS COURTS - NOW OPEN

PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT – NOW OPEN, WITH SIGNAGE THAT THE EQUIPMENT IS NOT SANITIZED ON A REGULAR BASIS

OUTDOOR RESTROOMS – OPENING SOON, WITH SIGNAGE THAT THE RESTROOMS ARE MAINTAINED ONCE DAILY BY OUR SERVICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL

PAVILIONS – NOT YET AVAILABLE FOR RENT. THEY WILL BE ROPED OFF TO AVOID UNSCHEDULED EVENTS UNTIL THE LCGHD AND CDC GUIDELINES PERMIT PUBLIC PICNICS. IN THE MEANTIME, RESIDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENJOY FAMILY PICNICS AT HOME.

BASEBALL FIELDS – AVAILABLE FOR WILLOUGHBY HILLS YOUTH SPORTS LEAGUE TEAMS ONLY, WHERE COACHES HAVE BEEN ADVISED ON COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES.

Spring is here, and Residents are starting to think of projects

Before starting any project, check to see if a permit is required. Some projects may even require a review process.

Plan ahead for these projects due to the review timeframe.

Examples of Zoning Permits that can be issued with an in-house review:

- Drive Apron
- Basement Waterproofing (exterior)
- Demolition
- Drive Culvert
- Excavation Hauling (Also Requires a Bond)
- Roofing
- Siding
- Street Opening (Also Requires a Bond)
- Above Ground Pool (additional permit required through the Lake County Building Department)
- Window and/or Door Replacement
- Accessory Structures 199 Square Feet or Less (Ex: Sheds)
- Driveway/Parkway/Patio/Walkway
- Fence/Wall
- Drainage

Examples of permits that require additional reviews (Planning Commission, Architectural Board of Review, Board of Zoning Appeals), City Permits and LCBD Permits:

- Accessory Structures 200 Square Feet or more (Ex: Shed, Detached Garages)
- Additions
- Attached Garages
- Decks
- Sunrooms, Screened Porches, and 3-Season Rooms
- Greenhouses
- In-Ground Pools
- New Homes

FIRE DEPARTMENT NEWS:

BURNING LEAVES IS PROHIBITED IN WILLOUGHBY HILLS. THE CITY HAS PROVIDED A MEANS TO DISPOSE OF THEM. PLEASE BE MINDFUL OF THIS AS YOU BEGIN YOUR SPRING CLEANUP.

GRILLING SAFETY – PROPANE & CHARCOAL BBQ GRILLS SHOULD ONLY BE USED OUTDOORS. THE GRILL SHOULD BE PLACED WELL AWAY FROM THE HOME, DECK RAILINGS AND OUT FROM UNDER EAVES AND OVERHANGING BRANCHES. KEEP CHILDREN AND PETS AT LEAST THREE FEET AWAY FROM THE GRILL AREA. KEEP YOUR GRILL CLEAN BY REMOVING GREASE OR FAT BUILDUP FROM THE GRILLS AND IN TRAYS BELOW THE GRILL. ELECTRONICS COLLECTION: APRIL 24 & AUGUST 14, 2021 8AM TO 2PM FREE EVENT

All personal data is secure as all hard drives are professionally erased in a secure facility. **ACCEPTED:** Battery back-ups, cable boxes, CD/DVDs, CD/VCR/DVD players, cell phones, circuit boards, coffee makers, computers/towers, curling irons, digital cameras, digital office phones, docking stations, fax machines, game systems, hairdryers, hard drives, keyboards, laptops, microphones, microwaves, modems/networking, printers, radios, scanners, servers, speakers, switches, tablets, toasters, wires/cables, typewriters, vacuums and most other corded or rechargeable household electronics. **PROHIBITED:** Any item on a trailer, any large appliances (stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, etc.), batteries (alkaline, wet cell, dry cell), televisions, broken/bare CRTs, computer monitors, any light bulb, carbon monoxide detectors, exercise equipment (bike, elliptical, treadmill, etc.), cassette tapes, gas-powered equipment, Freon containing devices/materials (refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, etc.), household hazardous waste, materials containing liquids, devices containing liquid mercury (thermostats, switches, medical devices, thermometers), PCB containing materials, propane tanks, radioactive materials, smoke detectors.

TIRE COLLECTION: MAY 1, 2021 8AM TO 2PM *FEES MAY APPLY

ACCEPTED: Up to six (6) car or light-truck tires unmounted from the rim will be accepted for FREE. Additional tires unmounted are \$2 each, tires mounted on a rim are \$4 each and oversized tires are \$10 each paid by *cash/check only. Television Collection - May 8 & August 14, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m. *Fees may apply. ACCEPTED: Flat/LCD/Plasma screens any size are FREE, screens sized smaller than 21 inches are \$5 each and screens sized larger than 21 inches or projection & console sets are \$10 each paid by *cash/check only. **PROHIBITED**: Any item on a trailer and any other type of electronics.

HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION: JUNE 5 & SEPT. 25, 2021 8AM TO 2PM FREE EVENT

ACCEPTED: Motor oil, gasoline, coolants, antifreeze, grease. oil-based paints, varnish, shellacs, stains, aerosols, polyurethanes, primers & grout. Bulbs & batteries of any size or kind. Fluorescent bulbs, household cleaners & solvents. Thinners, kerosene, turpentine, lighter fluid & paint strippers. Pool, lawn, & garden chemicals. Pesticides, weed killers, spray insecticides, "hobby" chemicals, mercury, empty propane tanks, roofing tars, drive sealers, & adhesives. **PROHIBITED:** Ammunition, explosives, latex paint, medical waste, prescription medicines, smoke alarms, or any other item not on the accepted list.
