MAYOR GARDNER'S REPORT:

This E-newsletter will be a few days early this week, but I wanted to make sure our residents received the information about upcoming meetings for next week, as well as a reminder to schedule for the COVID-19 booster through www.armorvax.com or by calling the Lake County General Health District at 440-350-2188. (No one will be available to do sign ups in the Mayor's Office from April 20 through April 22, 2022).

An important notice we received from Lake County Solid Waste District this week advised the City that the county will no longer be designating certain days for hazardous waste/recycling days. They have partnered with the Department of Utilities to repurpose an area at the Landfill and Recycling Center in Painesville Twp. into a drop-off site. This repurposed location is at 2039 Blasé Nemeth Road Painesville Twp. and will be a one-stop-shop allowing residents to bring recyclable items and household waste materials to one location, in one trip. This change also brings welcomed improvements such as expanded hours, the added convenience of credit card payments and expanded space for trailers to be utilized for hauling multiple items to the facility. This permanent recycling drop-off area will be open to residents from June 6 through August 31 during the landfill's standard business hours (Monday through Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. and Saturdays 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.). 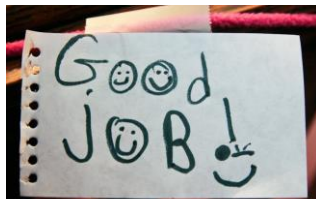
