### **MAYOR GARDNER'S REPORT:**

We are so lucky that the weather is cooperating this weekend for our Garage Sale Day. Thanks to the many residents who signed up for the event, which is featured later in this newsletter. We have provided a list of all of the registered participating addresses, as well as a convenient map to make sure you can see them all.

United Way of Lake County's annual Campaign begins on Tuesday, May 3 and features three weekly back-to-back Virtual "Community Hero" raffles. We will be emailing our readers a weekly link (as soon as it become available from United Way of Lake County) and the raffle runs for one week. 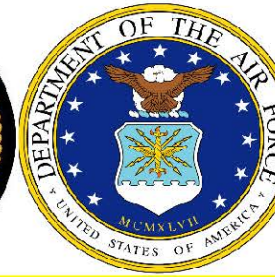

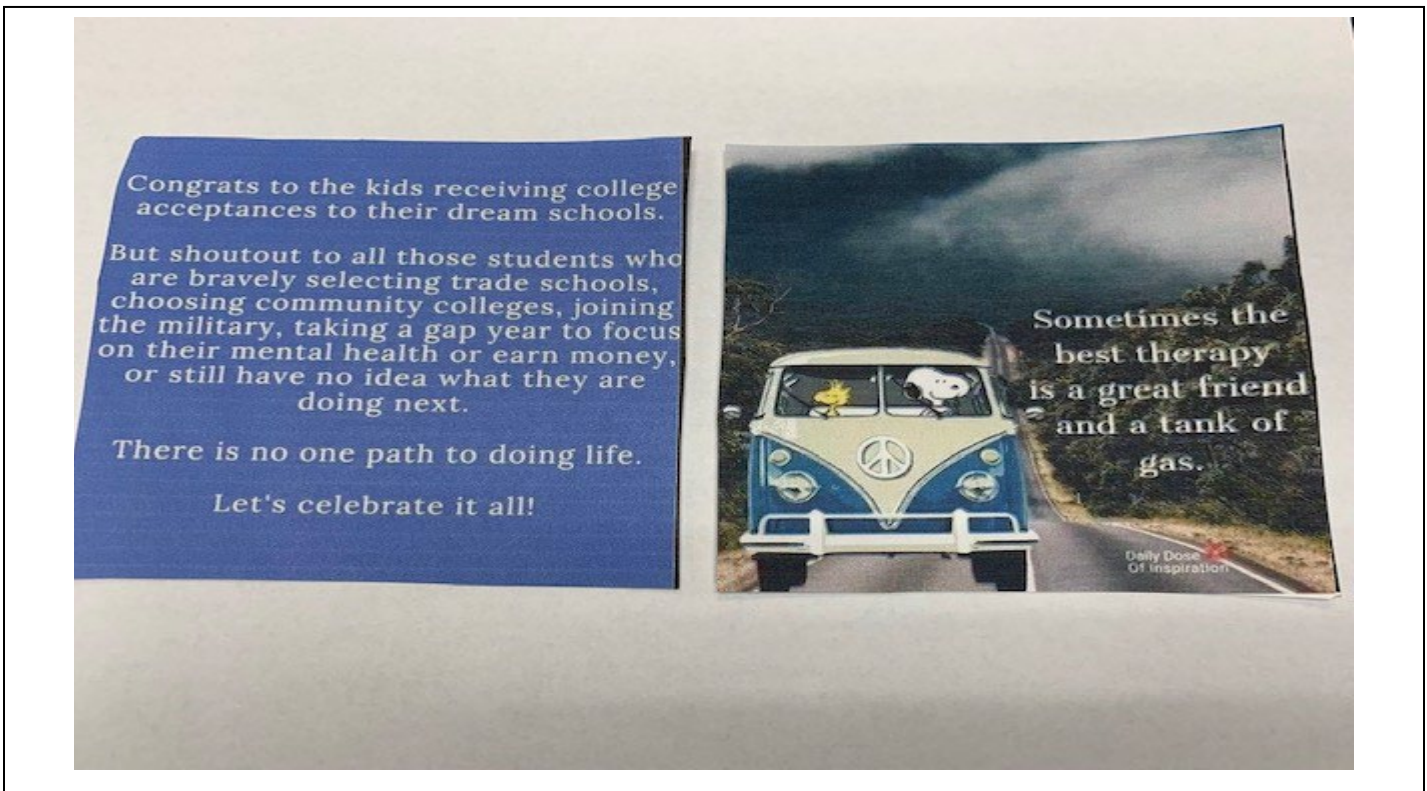

The marker and American flag will then be displayed at the Willoughby Hills Veterans' Memorial at Willoughby Hills Community Center, 35400 Chardon Road, Willoughby Hills during the month of May. The marker and flag will then be returned to the donor. All donations will be given to the Willoughby Hills VFW Post 4358 to assist with operating expenses. Your support is greatly appreciated and we are happy to remember your loved one who served or is serving our country!

## INFORMATION REGARDING CHARDON ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT:

The following information has been provided by Assistant City Engineer Kevin Trepal:

1. Project was awarded to Ronyak Paving.
2. Project schedule shows work starting on 5/2/22 and ending by 10/15/22. Lane closures are scheduled to start on 5/9/22.
3. Work will be completed in two phases:
  - a. Phase 1: Work zone will be setup between SR-91 & SR-174 with the eastbound lane of traffic closed. Eastbound traffic will be detoured to the north along Eddy Rd.
  - b. Phase 2: Work zone will be setup between SR-174 & Worrell Rd with the westbound lane of traffic closed. Westbound traffic will be detoured to the south along Rogers Rd.
4. Work hours are 7:30 AM to 5:30 PM, Monday through Friday. Four 10-hour workdays are expected with a fifth day and/or Saturday available as needed to meet the project schedule.
5. Access to all businesses and residential properties will be maintained throughout construction.
6. No construction staging areas are anticipated. Contractor will mobilize in/out each day.
