## EDITOR'S REFLECTION ON NATIONAL FIREFIGHTER'S DAY....

AS WE REFLECT ON THE ROLE OF OUR FIREFIGHTERS TODAY AS WE CELEBRATE "NATIONAL FIREFIGHTERS' DAY," I WANTED TO SHARE MY THOUGHTS ON THIS SPECIAL DAY.

AS A FIREFIGHTER'S WIFE, I KNOW FIRSTHAND HOW SPECIAL A FIREFIGHTER IS. HE OR SHE COMMITS THEMSELF TO THE FIRE SERVICE, KNOWING THE RISKS AND DANGERS OF THE JOB, YET WILLING TO MAKE THAT COMMITMENT OF SELF.

A FIREFIGHTER COMMITS TO A JOB WHEN THEY KNOW IT MAY MEAN THAT HOLIDAYS AND SPECIAL EVENTS ARE ONES THAT THEY MAY HAVE TO LEAVE EARLY, ARRIVE LATE, OR NOT ATTEND AT ALL, GIVEN THE UNCERTAIN HOURS OF THEIR JOB.

A FIREFIGHTER COMMITS TO THE JOB OF FIRE SERVICE, RECOGNIZING THAT THIS IS OFTEN THOUGHT TO BE A "YOUNGER PERSON'S JOB," KNOWING THE STRESS ON THEIR BACKS, LIMBS AND JOINTS AS THEY AGE.

A FIREFIGHTER COMMITS TO BEING THE FIRST ONE ON-SCENE, KNOWING THAT THEY MUST SERVE THE PUBLIC WITHOUT FEAR AND BE READY TO FACE ANY OBSTACLE THAT LIES BEFORE THEM. THEY NEVER KNOW WHAT THEY WILL ENCOUNTER, BUT PROCEED WITH THE SAME LEVEL OF COMMITMENT AND SERVICE.

A FIREFIGHTER MUST COME HOME AFTER THAT AWFUL CALL AND EXPECT THAT HE/SHE WILL FALL ASLEEP, JUST LIKE ANY OTHER NIGHT.

WITH THE RECENT GUIDELINES PUBLISHED BY THE LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT AND CDC,
THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS HAS ESTABLISHED THE FOLLOWING POLICY UPDATES FOR PARKS &
RECREATION:

BASKETBALL COURTS - CLOSED (DUE TO SOCIAL DISTANCING CONCERNS)

TENNIS COURTS - NOW OPEN

PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT – NOW OPEN, WITH SIGNAGE THAT THE EQUIPMENT IS NOT SANITIZED ON A REGULAR BASIS

OUTDOOR RESTROOMS – OPENING SOON, WITH SIGNAGE THAT THE RESTROOMS ARE MAINTAINED
ONCE DAILY BY OUR SERVICE DEPARTMENT PERSONNEL

PAVILIONS – NOT YET AVAILABLE FOR RENT. THEY WILL BE ROPED OFF TO AVOID UNSCHEDULED EVENTS UNTIL THE LCGHD AND CDC GUIDELINES PERMIT PUBLIC PICNICS. IN THE MEANTIME, RESIDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO ENJOY FAMILY PICNICS AT HOME.

BASEBALL FIELDS – AVAILABLE FOR WILLOUGHBY HILLS YOUTH SPORTS LEAGUE TEAMS ONLY, WHERE COACHES HAVE BEEN ADVISED ON COVID-19 SAFETY MEASURES.

#### **BUILDING DEPARTMENT UPDATE:**

OUR RESIDENTS ARE HAPPY THAT THE BRUSH PICK UP THROUGH REPUBLIC SERVICES IS NOW AVAILABLE ON THE SAME DAY AS THEIR TRASH PICKUP. JUST REMEMBER TO PUT THE YARD WASTE (IN BROWN BAGS OR BUNDLED IN 4 FOOT LENGTHS) OUT ON THE DAY OF YOUR NORMAL TRASH PICKUP (NO EARLIER, PLEASE!) AND REPUBLIC WILL PICK IT UP.

THERE WERE A FEW TIMES THIS MONTH (WITH THE INCREASE IN VOLUME OF RESIDENT CLEAN UP DUE TO NICE WEATHER AND ALSO DOWNED TREES FROM THE APRIL STORMS), THAT REPUBLIC ARRIVED A DAY LATER THAN EXPECTED, BUT REST ASSURED THAT THEY WILL BE BY TO PICK UP YOUR YARD WASTE!

# POOL PASS UPDATE:

WITHOUT A PUBLIC POOL IN THE CITY, WE RELY ON OUR NEIGHBORS TO PROVIDE THAT PIECE OF RECREATION AND THEN OFFER A SUBSIDY OR REIMBURSEMENT FOR OUR RESIDENTS.

THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY RECREATION IS AS FOLLOWS:

OSBORNE POOL WILL BE THE POOL AVAILABLE TO WILLOUGHBY HILLS RESIDENTS, OPENING ON SATURDAY, MAY 29 UNTIL AUGUST 15. AFTER THAT DATE, THE POOL WILL BE OPEN ON WEEKENDS ONLY (NOON TO 5PM) UNTIL LABOR DAY. POOL PASSES WILL COST \$125 PER PERSON AND WILLOUGHBY HILLS WILL OFFER A REFUND OF \$25 PER PASS TO INDIVIDUALS, OR \$35 PER PASS TO SENIORS (AGE 60 AND OVER). RESIDENTS SIMPLY PROVIDE A COPY OF THE RECEIPT PAID TO THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY AND WILL RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT, AS NOTED.

WE ARE STILL ATTEMPTING TO WORK WITH THE YMCA FOR POOL PRIVILEGES AND WILL KEEP YOU POSTED AS THAT INFORMATION BECOMES AVAILABLE. IF AVAILABLE, RESIDENTS HAVE THE REIMBURSEMENT OPTION FOR ONLY ONE OF TWO POOL OPTIONS.
