MASK AND SOCIAL DISTANCING MANDATES:

POOL PASS UPDATE

JUST A REMINDER ABOUT POOL PASS REIMBURSEMENT FOR WILLOUGHBY HILLS RESIDENTS:

WITHOUT A PUBLIC POOL IN THE CITY, WE RELY ON OUR NEIGHBORS TO PROVIDE THAT PIECE OF RECREATION AND THEN OFFER A SUBSIDY OR REIMBURSEMENT FOR OUR RESIDENTS.

THE INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY RECREATION IS AS FOLLOWS:
OSBORNE POOL WILL BE THE POOL AVAILABLE TO WILLOUGHBY HILLS RESIDENTS, OPENING ON
SATURDAY, MAY 29 UNTIL AUGUST 15. AFTER THAT DATE, THE POOL WILL BE OPEN ON WEEKENDS
ONLY (NOON TO 5PM) UNTIL LABOR DAY. POOL PASSES WILL COST \$125 PER PERSON AND WILLOUGHBY
HILLS WILL OFFER A REFUND OF \$25 PER PASS TO INDIVIDUALS, OR \$35 PER PASS TO SENIORS (AGE 60
AND OVER). RESIDENTS SIMPLY PROVIDE A COPY OF THE RECEIPT PAID TO THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY
AND WILL RECEIVE REIMBURSEMENT, AS NOTED.

A NOTE FROM MAYOR ANDY GARDNER:

Road Project update:

Chagrin Valley Paving has been contracted to resurface the asphalt pavement on Alan Drive, Diane Court, and Meadowbrook Drive this summer. Construction is anticipated to begin in early June and last until late July, barring any delays from weather or other unforeseen circumstances. The majority of the work will be performed between the hours of 7:30AM and 7:30PM Monday through Friday, however some work may occur on Saturdays. Access to driveways and traffic on the roads will be maintained at all times, however please be patient and cautious in the area during construction. Street parking will be prohibited during construction. Tree lawns and drive aprons are not expected to be disturbed. Notices will be delivered by the contractor shortly before commencing work. Please contact Jessica Rodriguez (Ph: 440-543-2253) with Chagrin Valley Paving if you have any special needs or concerns." Thanks in advance for your patience regarding dust and noise during this improvement project."

Road Striping:

JD Striping has begun City—wide road striping. They have been working at night to reduce traffic disturbance and will be using cones and signage to control traffic. All roads are expected to be fully striped within a few weeks. Please give the trucks and workers the distance they need to safely perform their job.

Campbell Park pavilions and Willoughby Hills Community Center will re-open on June 1 and the City is currently taking bookings for your summer events. Call the Recreation Office if you want to book an outside event at one of the two pavilions or the Community Center at 440-975-3540. With getting staffing back on track, you may need to leave a message, but you will be called back to schedule your event.

COVID Vaccine is now readily available at many locations. Please call my office if you need location information. Once vaccinated, don't forget to register for the vaccine million-dollar lottery/scholarship drawing being offered by the State of Ohio. Vaccination records will be verified for winners. Winners will be announced each Wednesday, starting May 26, at approximately 7:29 p.m., for five weeks. To be eligible to be announced as a winner on a given Wednesday, an Ohio resident must enter by the end of day the Sunday immediately prior. FIRE DEPARTMENT UPDATE RE. WATER VALVE REPLACEMENT:

The Lake County Department of Utilities will be replacing a water valve at the corner of White Rd and Bishop Road on Friday, May 21st 2021 starting 6:00 pm and lasting about 4 to 5 hours.

Locations without water during this time are:

- White Road (from 28540 going west to the county line.)
- Tall Tree Trail
- Legend Lane

The following complexes will see a reduction in water pressure

- Bishop Park Apartments
- Shoppes at Willoughby Hills
- Willoughby Hills Towers

Hydrant Flushing continues in the City this week, too! Please make sure the hydrant area is free of brush & debris so it is easily accessible to our Fire Department. Thank you!
