#### **MAYOR GARDNER'S REPORT:**

The recycle magnets are on the way! Residents should be receiving them this week, if they have not already. I have included a copy of the magnet in this newsletter that was approved by my office which may help you in the interim.

It may be the lazy, hazy days of summer, but work continues to get some very important City projects accomplished. Council will be reviewing bids that were received after a June 23 bid opening for the City Hall parking lot. This is broken into two contracts (A&B) which will account for the parking lot itself and then the concrete driveway leading into the complex. This is being done in concrete since our second project (the City Hall Salt Storage Structure) is also being constructed and may serve to break up an asphalt driveway, but not particularly a concrete driveway. Once Council approves the bids, we will move forward to get these projects started.

Our Chardon Road resurfacing project continues and is making very good progress. The road is open now for the entire stretch, having just finished the area from River to Worrell, using flaggers while motorists waited patiently to take their turn to get through. Thank you for your cooperation in this regard if you were one of those motorists! It truly looks (& feels) nice, without the bumps that previously were so burdensome.

The residents on Rivers Edge/River may have experienced a short power outage on Thursday at about 2:00 p.m. when a tree fell, taking down CEI power lines and causing a small fire. WHFD was on scene and power was eventually restored to the area. As you know, the City continues to work with First Energy to assess the cause of any power outages so I thought it was important to report this to our residents who may have been affected by this outage.

Chagrin River Watershed Partners (CRWP) is offering a Chagrin River Trail Workshop on Saturday, July 9 from 11am to 2pm at Squire's Castle, 2844 River Road. This is open to the public and will explore new ways to improve access to the Chagrin River. Come enjoy some free lemonade and give your input to CRWP.

In closing, I want to remind everyone that ODNR will be Council's guest at the Monday, July 11, 2022 6:00 p.m. meeting in Council Chambers and will discuss the deer population in our City. Feel free to come for this informative presentation.



#### **DOUBLECHECK FOR NOPEC OPTIONS:**

The July rates for NOPEC gas and electric follow on the next page, but please take a moment to check your bills to see what option you have chosen and if may be time to review for a cheaper plan. Some of the options had increased considerably since the April numbers and it is good to keep an eye out for the best pricing. The following rate page is a good start.

#### NOPEC RATES:

#### NOPEC RATES FOR GAS FOR JULY 2022:

Standard Plan \$5.990 per mcf

Monthly Variable Plan \$6.711 mcf 12-mo. Fixed Rate \$8.650 per mcf 24-mo. Fixed Rate \$7.750 per mcf

#### NOPEC RATES FOR ELECTRIC FOR JULY 2022:

Standard Plan 12.000 cents per kWh Monthly Variable Plan
Closed to new enrollment

12-mo. Fixed Rate 11.900 cents per kWh 24-mo. Fixed Rate 10.900 cents per kWh

Standard Plan – Automatically enrolled unless you pick another option or opt out totally. Monthly Variable – Guaranteed \$0.02/mcf less than Standard Option.

Maple Hill Road residents please note: You are not able to enroll in NOPEC since NEOGAS is the unique supplier to your street only, based upon the gas line installation that occurred when the Maple Hill Development was put in! Thanks to the great E-newsletter reader who helped locate this information to help his neighbors!

Please see the note below that the Mayor received from NOPEC Executive Director Chuck Keiper which is a good explanation of the NOPEC rates and challenges with pricing.

#### PAPER SHREDDING DATES & RECYCLING RESOURCES:

Pop Cans - WH Fire Department (to benefit the Burn Unit)

Old Flags - VFW or the Scout Troops (at the Grange Building or City Hall)

#### A NOTE FROM NOPEC'S EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR:

These are tough times in the energy industry. Gasoline, natural gas, and electricity prices have all doubled since 2021 and NOPEC is not immune to current market and inflationary spikes. Here's what NOPEC is doing to assist you, your residents and small businesses:

#### **NOPEC Electric Pricing**

- The current NOPEC electric price is more than the current utility Price To Compare (PTC). The current PTC is low because the utility began purchasing the power more than 11 months ago when prices were much lower. This difference will continue until May 2023 when the utility's pricing is expected to adjust to the current market and will likely increase. Until then, residents who are dissatisfied with NOPEC's current electric pricing can call the NOPEC Customer Care Center at 855-667-3201 and ask specifically to be dropped to the utility's default service at no charge- but not to "opt out". Residents who drop NOPEC now can always rejoin when markets normalize. Our customer service team will be ready to receive these calls and will explain the process and the consequences of 'opting out' instead of 'dropping'.
- Every three years we are required by the PUCO to send a letter to every NOPEC electric customer that includes updated pricing, rate options, terms, and opt out details. The next electric letter is expected to be mailed early (in mid-September) so that we can offer a more predictable and competitive rate starting January 1, 2023.

#### **NOPEC Natural Gas Pricing**

Although the current NOPEC natural gas price has also increased due to the current market, the NOPEC price is still 12% LESS for Dominion and 28% less than the Columbia Standard Choice Offer (SCO) rates which are set monthly. NOPEC natural gas customers should be cautious of other retail offers that may end up costing them way more than the discounted rate they are receiving from NOPEC.

#### Final Message to Residents and Small Businesses

- · Please be patient. Despite these troubling times, energy markets will stabilize.
- · We have discovered that some nefarious energy suppliers are using this uncertainty to their own advantage. Please remind your residents and small businesses to be especially wary of offers that sound too good to be true. Most are deceptive and have costly consequences. Consumers should <a href="never">never</a> share their utility bill or account information with anyone that contacts them unprompted and should review the fine print <a href="yerry">yerry</a> carefully before signing any contract.
- As an extra precaution against high utility bills, NOPEC continues to closely monitor current energy-related regulation and legislation to strongly advocate against unfair passthrough charges and rate hikes.




