CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION UPDATE:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT #2 –THE MAYOR (ARTICLE II IN THE CHARTER), Subsection 2.21 Appointments to Office & Removals from Office:

Charter Review Commission prepared Amendment #2 with the following intent: The Charter Review Commission voted to clarify that the Mayor's ability to control the employment status should be limited to those positions under his supervision. The current language does not provide the clarity that is necessary to prevent him or her from hiring, supervising, and firing any and all positions of employment in the city of Willoughby Hills. Thus, this change would clarify that the Mayor is the administrator of all city employees, but he is not the administrator of Council.

What will change in the Charter then, if this amendment is adopted by the voters? In Section 2.21 Appointments to Office and Removals from Office, the last sentence in paragraph #1 will be changed from:

"The Mayor shall have the authority to hire, supervise, and fire all other employees."

To

"The Mayor shall have the sole authority to hire, supervise and fire all other employees to whom he may appoint a successor unless otherwise provided by this Charter."

THIS IS HOW THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT WILL APPEAR ON THE BALLOT:

"PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT- #2
A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall Article II, Sub-Section 2.21 – Appointments to Office and Removals from Office of the Charter of the City of Willoughby Hills be amended to provide that the Mayor shall have the sole authority to hire, supervise, and fire <u>only</u> employees under his supervision which does not include Council Members or the Council Clerk unless provided to the contrary in the Charter?"
