#### **BUILDING DEPARTMENT UPDATE:**

THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT HAS RECEIVED CALLS RECENTLY REGARDING INVOICES THAT RESIDENTS WITH SEPTIC TANKS ARE RECEIVING. THE CALLERS WANT TO VERIFY THAT IT IS A LEGITIMATE INVOICE AND NOT A SCAM.

THE LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT HAS CONFIRMED THAT THE INVOICES <u>ARE</u> LEGITIMATE. MOST OF THESE INVOICES ARE \$100, WHICH COVERS A TOTAL OF FIVE YEARS (\$20/YEAR). THE RESIDENT NEEDS TO SUBMIT THE \$100 WITH A CERTIFICATE FROM A LEGITIMATE SEPTIC COMPANY SHOWING THAT THEY HAVE HAD THE SYSTEM PUMPED/SERVICED IN ORDER FOR THE PERMIT TO BE GOOD FOR FIVE YEARS. THIS INFORMATION IS PROVIDED WITH THE INVOICE, PER THE LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT. PLEASE CHECK THE CITY WEBSITE REGARDING THE LAKE COUNTY GENERAL HEALTH DISTRICT'S ROLE IN OVERSEEING SEPTIC SYSTEMS AT:

#### Halloween Safety Tips by Police Chief Matt Naegele

This year certainly is flying by! Fall is in full swing, kids are back to school, and Halloween is right around the corner. It's an exciting day for children and parents alike, but can present some safety challenges. This year, take some time to consider basic safety precautions that will make your children's Halloween a safer night of fun – and perhaps a little less stressful for the parents.

#### Thinking ahead

- Choose bright costumes (Hint Add reflective tape to costumes and candy bags!)
- Plan a trick-or-treating route in familiar neighborhoods with well-lit streets
- Make sure children know their home phone number (or parent's cell number) and address in case you get separated
- Teach them how to call 911 in an emergency
- Teach children to say "No!" in a loud voice if someone tries to get them to go somewhere, accept anything other than a treat, or leave with them

#### Halloween Night

- Never send younger children out alone they should be with a parent or guardian, or another trusted adult
- Always walk younger children to the door to receive treats
- Don't let children enter a home unless you are with them
- Be sure children do not approach any vehicle, occupied or not, unless you are with them
- Discuss basic pedestrian safety rules when walking to and from houses

#### FIRSTENERGY UPDATE

ON TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26 AT APPROXIMATELY 2:30 P.M., THE MAYOR'S OFFICE RECEIVED SEVERAL CALLS FROM RESIDENTS IN THE DODD ROAD AND ROGERS ROAD AREAS CONCERNING A POWER OUTAGE. THE REPORT WAS THAT THE "POWER FLICKERED FOR A BIT AND THEN WENT OUT." THE POWER WAS RESTORED ABOUT 1.5 HOURS LATER. UPON CONTACTING THE FIRSTENERGY REPRESENTATIVE, THE CITY RECEIVED THE FOLLOWING OUTAGE REPORT AT 3:50 P.M.:

"There is a tree limb laying across all three primaries. The outage impacted 1184 customers and currently all but 384 customers are restored. Estimated time of restoration is 5:00 p.m."

The City is currently reviewing the location of the tree limb that caused the outage, which may be helpful in reducing future outages and inconvenience for residents.



As reported in the October 23, 2021 News-Herald article, Project Hope for the Homeless recently unveiled a new branding strategy and logo. The shelter is a 50-bed facility located at 25 Freedom Road in Painesville and has provided emergency and transitional shelter, care and guidance to more than 8,000 people since inception.

The only emergency shelter in Lake County — in its 28th year of operation — has been known by many area residents by the shorter name of "Project Hope." However, it is embarking on a strategy change to distinguish itself with a new organizational look including a new logo with different organizational colors and emphasizing use of its full name in all references.

A change was needed after discovering increased confusion with an international health organization based in Washington D.C. that uses this shorter name Project Hope, including owning and using that online domain name, according to a news release.

The new colors also convey a sense of warmth, comfort, and healing within a modernized logo that is easier to read and includes the organization's motto "Restoring Hope. Renewing Lives."

Best wishes to Project Hope as they continue to do good work in our county through their generous and worthwhile efforts.
