MAYOR GARDNER'S REPORT:

Please plan to take a few moments and stop by the Willoughby Hills Marc's Store (in the Shoppes of Willoughby Hills) tomorrow, Saturday, November 19th between 10:00 A.M. and 2:00 P.M. to help fill a police cruiser with food to help those in need this Holiday Season. The Police Department is also conducting a Toy Drive in conjunction with Willoughby Hills Friends Church and The Cleveland Clinic to help area families in need, please see the flyers later in this Newsletter.

The Council's Deer Management Committee held two meetings recently (Nov. 1 and Nov. 14) to discuss curbing the City's deer population by allowing residents to archery hunt on their property. Topics discussed thus far include minimum acreage, permit/licensing, age limits, and proof of proficiency. Also being discussed by the Committee are various other ways of deterring deer from damaging property (ODNR education, useful information posted to the City's website, etc.). Residents are strongly encouraged to voice their opinion on this topic at the next City Council meeting (December 8th) or by contacting your Council representative with concerns.

With the Holidays fast approaching, please note that the City will be offering a variety of programs for our residents. Winterfest and the lighting of Christmas Card Lane will be December 4, 2022 from 5:00 P.M. until 6:30 P.M. in the Fire Station. Willoughby South's Holiday Band will perform and there will be games and snacks for the kids. Santa will also be there to visit with everyone. Registration for Breakfast with Santa has started (see the flyers later in this Newsletter) and is filling up fast. As noted last week, the City is requiring that all residential snow plow contractors register with the City. Registration is being completed through the Service Department and is only \$25.00 for the contractor's first vehicle and \$5.00 for any additional vehicles operating in the City. As well as their contact information, contractors will need to provide proof of insurance and their customer list. Contractors will be provided with copies of City ordinances including requirements: (i) that plowed snow not be left in the streets or on any neighbor's property, (ii) that plowed snow not be so high that it obstructs or impairs the vision of pedestrians or motorists and (iii) that the plowed snow does not block access to any fire hydrants.
