### **“ONE MORE ATTEMPT TO RECEIVE LAKE COUNTY SR. TAX LEVY FUNDS!”**

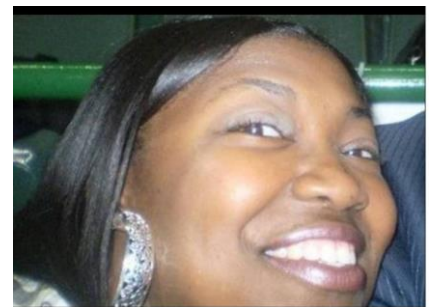
Senior Board Member Gloria Majeski and former Council President Dave Reichelt attended the Lake County Senior Services Committee meeting on Tuesday. The Committee had agreed to give the denial of our application for Senior Tax Levy funding a second look. Dave and Gloria were able to substantiate the reasons why our Senior Center deserves funding, just as all of the other Lake County Senior Centers who submitted applications, to enable us to provide a facility and programs that seniors in Willoughby Hills and neighboring communities will enjoy. The Committee was receptive to our request and was going to take a vote as to whether this should be put back in front of the Commissioners for a final vote. Commissioner Regovich was present at the meeting, so we are hopeful that our concerns will have been heard by the Committee and then taken back to the Commissioners for a vote to receive the full funding that we requested last October. We will keep you posted as things progress.
