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RESOLUTION 2023-018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN EXPENDITURE OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000.00) FOR THE PURCHASE AND SUBSCRIPTION OF FLOCK SAFETY EQUIPMENT FROM FLOCK GROUP, INC. FOR A FIVE (5) YEAR TERM FOR USE BY THE WILLOUGHBY HILLS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has received a quote of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) from Flock Group, Inc. for the purchase and subscription of Flock Safety equipment for a five (5) year term for use by the Willoughby Hills Police Department and its eight (8) vehicle license readers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILLOUGHBY HILLS, STATE OF OHIO THAT:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Flock Group, Inc. in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollar (\$100,000.00) for the purchase and subscription of Flock Safety Equipment for a five (5) year term for use by the Willoughby Hills Police Department and in accordance with the attached quote and supporting memorandum annexed as **Exhibit A** and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. The Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution have been taken at open meetings of this Council; and that deliberations of this Council and of its committees, resulting in such formal action, took place in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all statutory requirements including the requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Willoughby Hills; and for the further reason that the purchase authorized herein is necessary to maintain effective law enforcement; and it shall take effect immediately upon passage by the affirmative vote of not less than five (5) members elected to Council and approval by the Mayor or otherwise at the earliest time allowed by law.
