The Board of City Commissioners met in regular session, Monday, April 03, 2023 at 5:30 p.m. in the City Commission-Community Council Meeting Room, City Hall; Mayor Gregory N. Thompson presiding. Commissioners Brenda K. Butters and Ronald E. Hutto were also present. Also in attendance were Taggart Wall, City Manager; Tania Richardson, City Clerk; and William E. Muret, City Attorney. Other staff member present was Patrick Steward, Director of Community Development.

Mayor Thompson noted all Commissioners present.

Commissioner Butters moved that the minutes of the March 20, 2023 meeting be approved. Commissioner Hutto seconded the motion. With all Commissioners voting aye, motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Bill No. 2324 – An Ordinance – Accepting and authorizing the final plat of the Broadway Estates Subdivision, in the Northeast quarter of Section 33, Township 32 South, Range 4 East of the 6th P.M., Winfield, Cowley County, Kansas. Director of Community Development Steward explains this Ordinance will approve the final plat of the Broadway Estates Subdivision. Upon motion by Commissioner Hutto, seconded by Commissioner Butters, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2324 was adopted and numbered Ordinance No. 4197.

Bill No. 2325 – A Resolution – Authorizing and directing the Mayor and Clerk of the City of Winfield, Kansas, to execute Transportation Alternatives Project Agreement No. 047-23 between the City and the Secretary of the Kansas Department of Transportation, relating to State Aid for the improvement of US-160 Pedestrian Path. Director of Community Development Steward explains this Resolution will approve the agreement with the Secretary of Transportation for funding for a transportation alternatives project. Upon motion by Commissioner Butters, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2325 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2223.

Bill No. 2326 – A Resolution – Authorizing and directing the City Manager and Clerk of the City of Winfield, Kansas to enter into an agreement between Versasport, LLC., Wichita, Kansas and the

City of Winfield, Kansas, regarding playground improvements at Cochran Park. Director of Community Development Steward explains this Resolution authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement for installation of playground improvements at Cochran Park in the amount of \$101,462.00. Upon motion by Commissioner Hutto, seconded by Commissioner Butters, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2326 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2323.




ADJOURNMENT
