OTHER BUSINESS

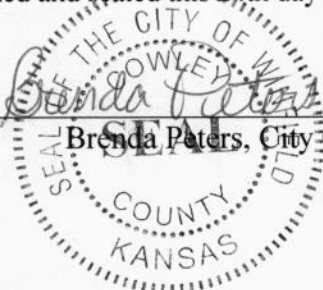

Commissioner Thompson made a motion to approve the Drinking Establishment License application received from Francisco Ramirez, d/b/a/ El Maguey, for transfer of address from 1515 E 9th Ave to 3727 Quail Ridge Dr, pending successful inspection. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Jarvis. With all Commissioners voting aye, motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT


