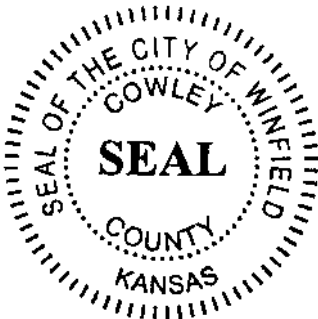

**CITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**  
**Winfield, Kansas**  
**April 18, 2022**

The Board of City Commissioners met in regular session, Monday, April 18, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. in the City Commission-Community Council Meeting Room, City Hall; Mayor Ronald E. Hutto presiding. Commissioners Gregory N. Thompson and Brenda K. Butters were present. Also in attendance were Taggart Wall, City Manager; Brenda Peters, City Clerk and William E. Muret, City Attorney. Other staff members present were Patrick Steward, Director of Community Development; and Eryn Ebach Freund, Community Development Coordinator/Planner.

City Clerk Peters called roll.

Commissioner Thompson moved that the minutes of the April 4, 2022 meeting be approved. Commissioner Butters seconded the motion. With both Commissioners voting aye, motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**Bill No. 2232 – An Ordinance** – Amending Chapter 6 of The Winfield City Code by the modification of enhanced cereal malt beverage curbside service. City Manager Wall explains this Ordinance would allow for the curbside pickup of CMB but continues the prohibition of delivery of CMB. Upon motion by Commissioner Butters, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2232 was adopted and numbered Ordinance No. 4181.

**Bill No. 2233 – A Resolution** – Authorizing an Outdoor Community Event and Temporary Entertainment District Application (Boneshaker Rides, LLC.) City Manager Wall explains this Resolution authorizes a Special Event on May 14, 2022, on West 6th Ave between Manning St and Main St. Upon motion by Commissioner Thompson, seconded by Commissioner Butters, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2233 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2522.

**Bill No. 2234 – A Resolution** – Authorizing the Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of Winfield, Kansas to execute a right-of-way use permit agreement between the City of Winfield, Kansas, and Brew Crew LLC, dba Scooter's Coffee to construct and maintain parking within the right-of-way. Community Development Coordinator/Planner Ebach Freund explains that this action authorizes the execution of a Right-Of-Way Use Agreement between the City and Brew Crew LLC, dba Scooter's Coffee and allows the construction and maintenance of seven off-street parking stalls in the right-of-way of E. 18th Avenue. Upon motion by Commissioner Butters, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 2234 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 2622.

## Request for Commission Action

Date: April 28, 2022

Requestor: Chief Vincent R Warren

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### Action Requested:

Replace our current bunker gear that is getting close to 8 years old. NFPA recommends bunker gear be replaced within 10 years of being put into service.

### Analysis:

Our current bunker gear needs replacement due to 8 years of heavy use and to properly protect our Fire/EMS personnel during fire and rescue emergency incidents. A committee was formed of personnel last year to begin the process of determining the best personnel protective gear for our department. After visits from vendors and interaction with other fire departments our committee settled on Honeywell gear.

Honeywell gear seemed to offer the best protection for our fire personnel. Talking with other departments in the area Honeywell was the most preferred and seemed to hold up longer through wear and tear.

Delta Fire also provides loaner gear at no charge for instances where gear needs to be repaired at the factory or a through cleaning needs to be done due to exposure to hazardous materials and chemicals. This is all done in house through Delta which is based around the Dallas Texas area. Other vendors used an outside source not directly related to the company for repairs and cleaning.

### Fiscal Impact:

The current project is projected to take two phases. The first phase will equip new personnel protective gear for 12 individuals. The second phase will equip personnel protective gear for 15 individuals. This will complete the gear replacement process until it is required again by 2032.

Phase 1 (2022) total: \$ 47,883.12
