

**CITY COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES**  
**Winfield, Kansas**  
**October 17, 2022**

The Board of City Commissioners met in regular session, Monday, October 17, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. in the City Commission-Community Council Meeting Room, City Hall; Mayor Ronald E. Hutto presiding. Commissioners Brenda K. Butters and Gregory N. Thompson were also present. Also in attendance were Taggart Wall, City Manager; Tania Richardson, City Clerk; and William E. Muret, City Attorney. **NEW BUSINESS**

**Bill No. 22120 – A Resolution** – Authorizing the Project Programming Request and Commitment of City Funds for a Pedestrian Access Expansion. Director of Public Improvements Steward explains the estimated project cost in \$263,338 with a Federal TA award of \$210,670 (80%) and local project share of \$52,668 (20%). Upon motion by Commissioner Thompson, seconded by Commissioner Butters all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 22120 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 10022.

**Bill No. 22121 – A Resolution** – Approving set up of account with Pooled Money Investment Board of Kansas. City Manager Wall explains this will allow the City to set up an account with Pooled Money Investment Board of Kansas as an option to invest idle funds. Upon motion by Commissioner Butters, seconded by Commissioner Thompson all Commissioners voting aye, Bill No. 21115 was adopted and numbered Resolution No. 10122.

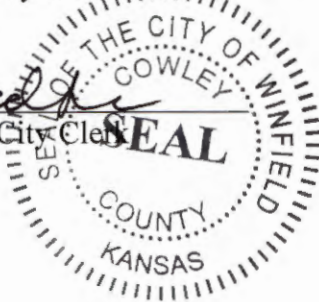


Upon motion by Commissioner Butters, seconded by Commissioner Thompson, all Commissioners voting aye, the meeting adjourned at 5:38 p.m.
