

August 7, 2025 Special meeting

Chairman Rasmussen called the special meeting of the Wright County Board of Supervisors to order at 10:02 a.m. Members present were Kluss, Rasmussen, Loux, and Ellis with Bosch present via Zoom.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Loux to approve the tentative agenda. Motion carries.

Adam Clemons, Wright County Engineer, Kyle Handy, Twin Rivers Exploration, LLC and Chris Davin, Koloma, met with the Board of Supervisors to discuss an amendment to the Wright County Road Use Agreement Application submitted by the aforesaid companies.

The amendment consists of implementing a proper permit fee and detailing the adjusted setbacks of the seismic testing.

The representatives answered questions regarding setbacks for seismic testing, insurance, and permit fees. The seismic testing shall not be within 250 feet of a bridge and was changed from 250 to within 25 feet of a roadway structure. Certificates of Insurance have already been filed with the Wright County Engineer. The permit fees collected will ensure that any damages, including but not limited to drainage tile and crop damage, that may not be covered by the insurance will be taken care of.

Motion by Ellis and seconded by Rasmussen to approve the amendment to the Wright County Road Use Agreement with Twin Rivers Exploration, LLC with a permit fee of \$110,000 and the applicant shall not perform any seismic testing within 250 feet of a bridge or within 25 feet of a roadway structure and shall monitor all roadway structures, and the monitored PPV value for that structure shall not go above 0.5 inches per second. Motion carries with Loux voting nay and Bosch being absent.

Motion by Kluss and seconded by Ellis to adjourn the meeting. Motion carries.
