CANDIDATE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS AND DEADLINE TO FILE		
Candidate Eligibility Requirements <i>Requisitos de Elegibilidad del Candidato</i>		Deadline to File Candidate Application** <i>Fecha Límite Para Presentar la Solicitud de Candidato**</i>
1. Shall be a United States citizen; 2. Shall be a qualified voter of the City 3. Shall have resided for at least 12 months preceding the election prior to the filing deadline. 4. Shall not, after notice of any delinquency, be in arrears in the payment of any taxes due to the City. 5. An incumbent councilman seeking reelection must file for the same place position number currently being served. 6. No candidate may file in a single election for more than one office or place position as provided by the Charter. 7. Candidates must be nominated by petition per City Charter and state law: City of Wylie Candidate Qualifications 8. Application and Petition must be filed together by the filing deadline.* 9. Candidate Packets, including the application and petition are available in the City Secretary's Office the first week of January. Candidates are strongly encouraged to obtain a candidate packet.		February 13, 2026 by 5:00 PM
*These forms are available on the Secretary of State website , but the full Candidate Packet (recommended) is obtained from the City Secretary.		
**The filing period begins on the 108th day prior to the election date and ends on the 78th day at 5 p.m. prior to the election date.
