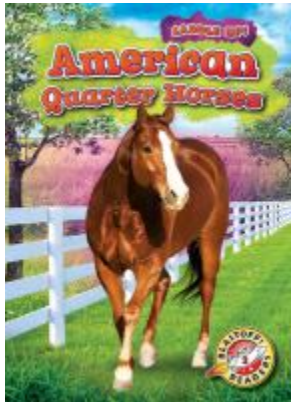

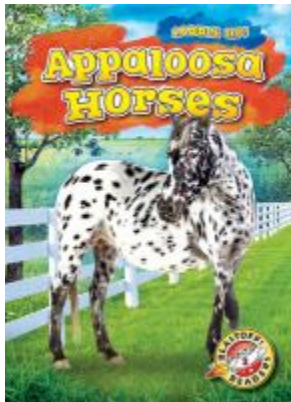

Summary

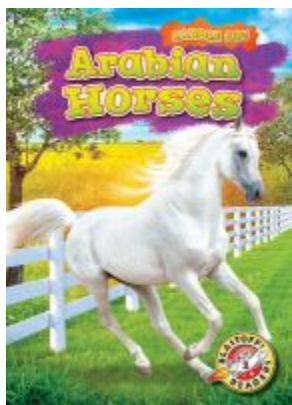

Summary

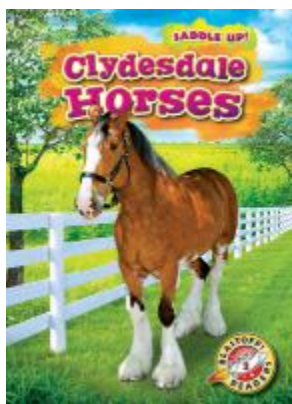

Summary

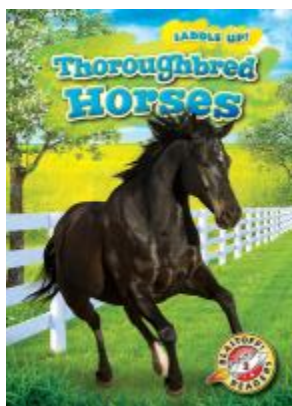

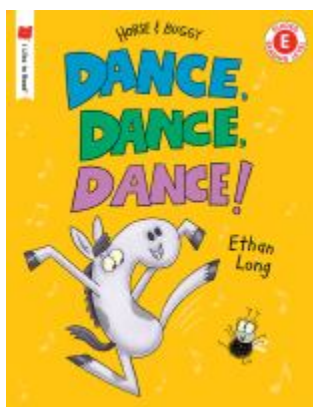

Summary

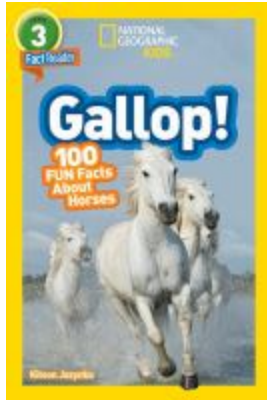

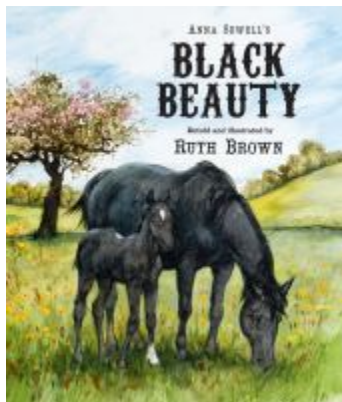

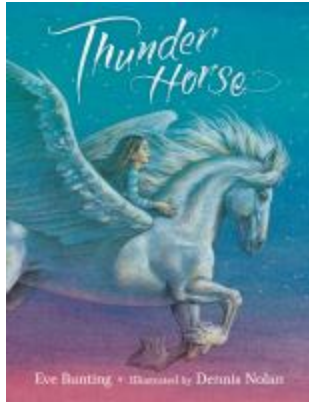

Summary

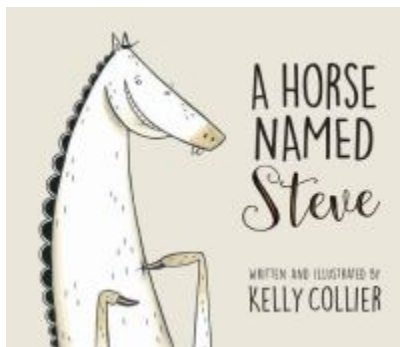

Summary

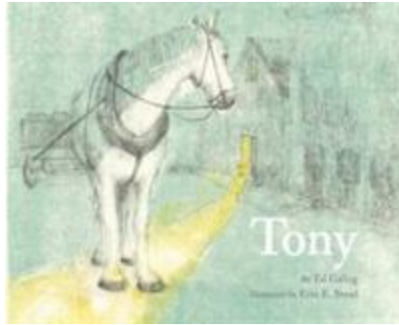
When a girl receives a small horse from her aunt, she doesn't quite know what to do with it. It turns out that this horse is a very special horse: it has wings.

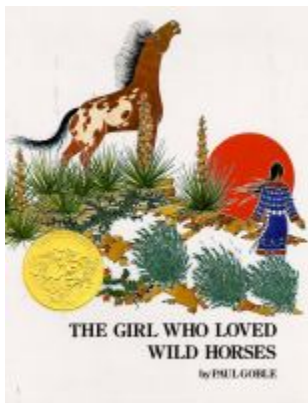


E GAL Tony by Galing, Ed 2017

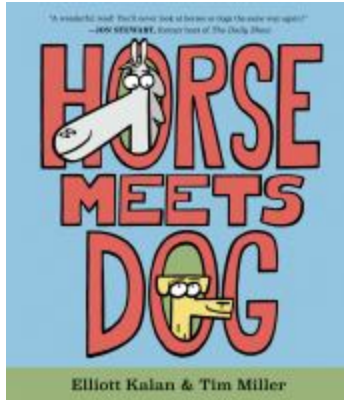


J CALD THE GIRL WHO LOVED WILD HORSES by Goble, Paul 2021

"There was a girl in the village who loved horses... She led the horses to drink at the river. She spoke softly and they followed. People noticed that she understood horses in a special way.

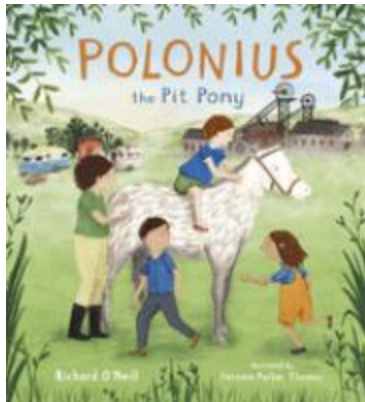


E KAL HORSE MEETS DOG by Kalan, Elliott 2018

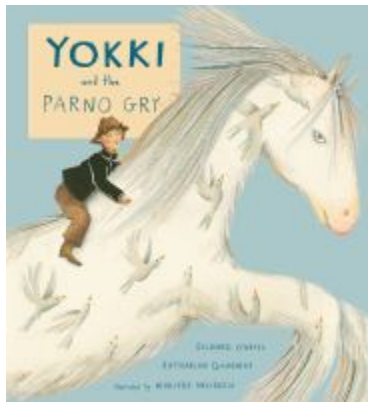
Horse is just an oversized dog with funny paws...according to Dog. And Dog? Just a tiny baby horse with a weird tail. That's what Horse thinks, anyway.

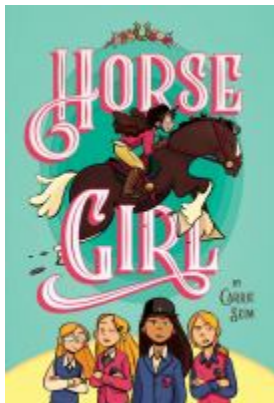

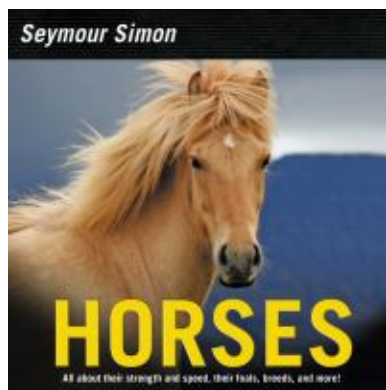


J F SEI HORSE GIRL by Seim, Carrie 2021

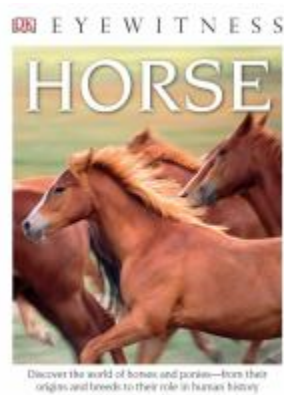

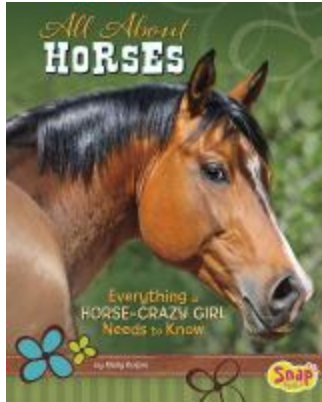
HORSE by Clutton-Brock, Juliet

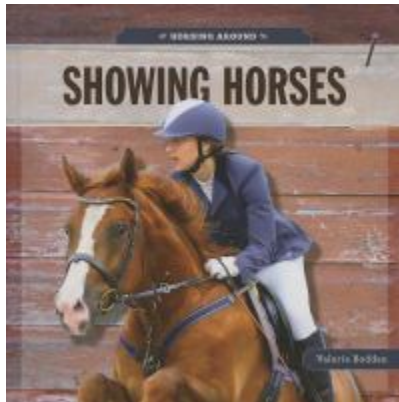

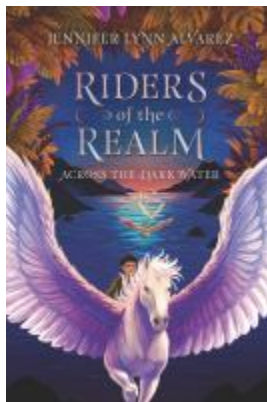

Summary

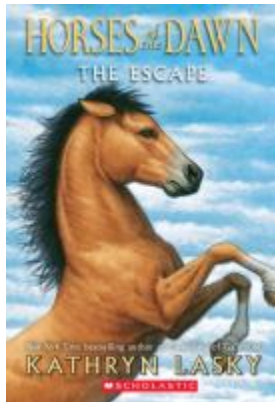

Summary

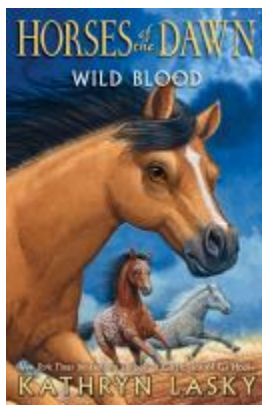

Summary

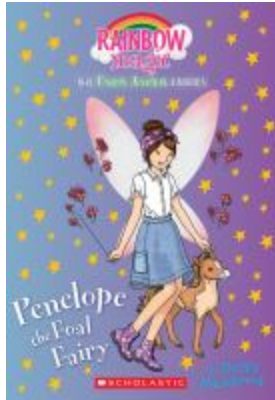
