December 9, 1953 to March 11, 2016

Leslee was the Director of the Saline District Library from 1989 until her death in 2016. She was a very active member of the Saline community and positioned the Library to be at its center. Over the years, Leslee represented the Library by serving in leadership roles for nearly every community organization and helped found the Saline Coalition for a Quality Community and Saline Leadership Institute. Leslee shared her passion for nature and art with the community by installing gardens, trails, and works of art throughout the Library grounds as well as by rotating art exhibits inside the building. She was a member of the Environmental Commission and the Lions Club. She was a frequent volunteer for the Saline Historical Society, 212 Art Center, Saline Farmers Market and other community activities where her fabulous smile welcomed all who knew her.

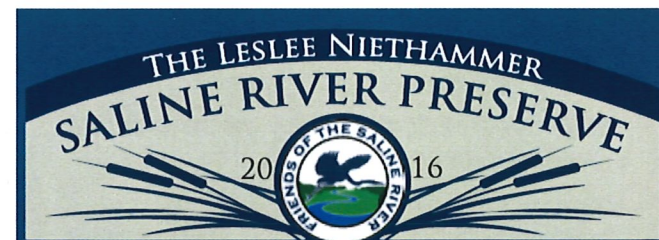
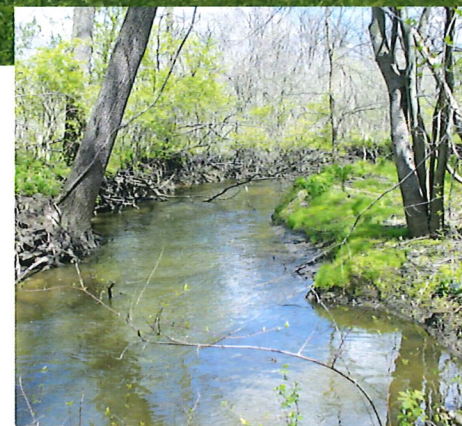

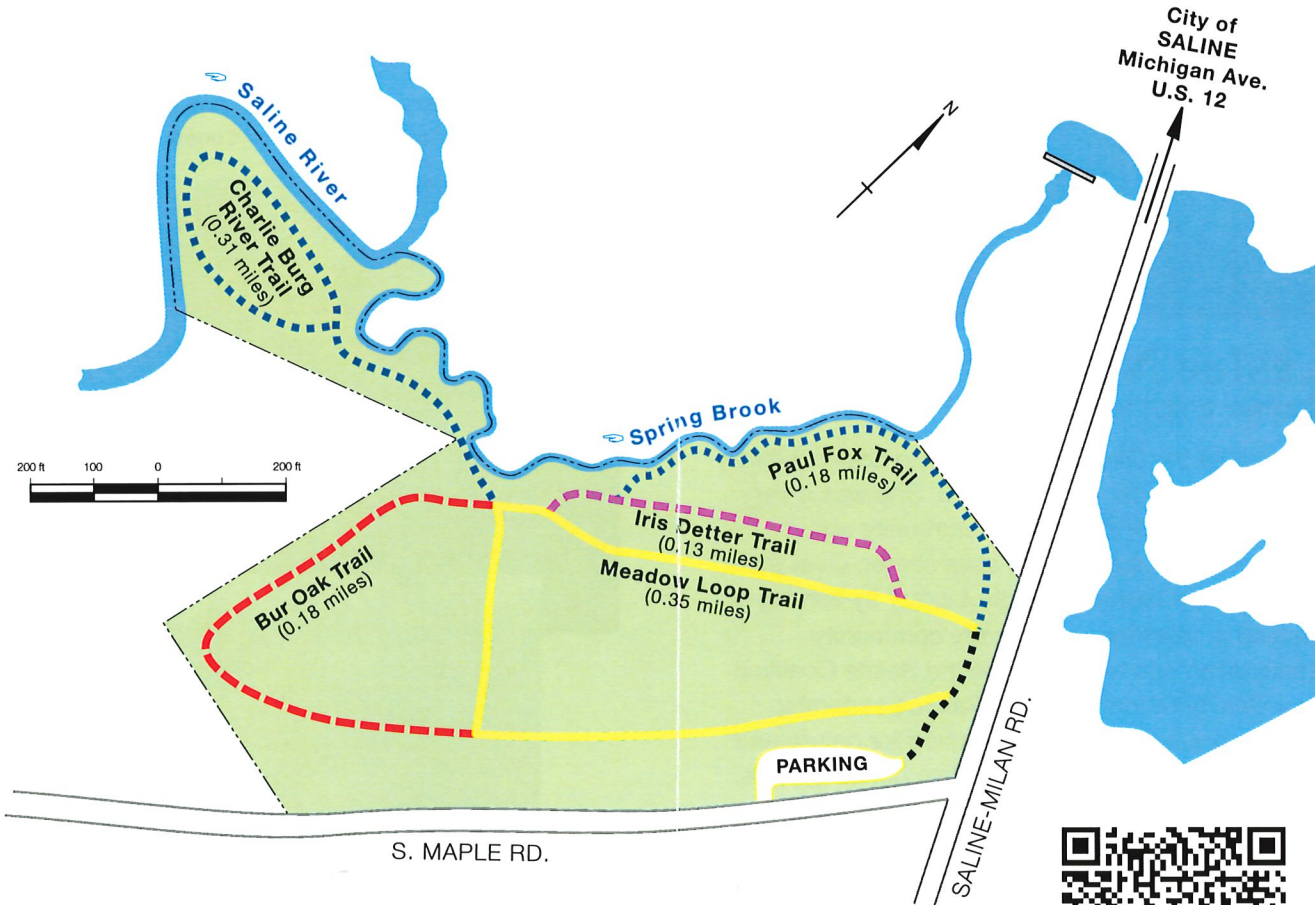

Preserve Rules:

While in the Preserve, no person shall:

- Possess or consume any alcoholic beverage.
- Possess and/or discharge any firearm or fireworks.
- Damage, deface or destroy any shrub, tree, flower or other public property, or throw or deposit litter other than in designated containers.
- Hunt, trap or attempt to trap any animal or fowl on the premises.
- Build or maintain any fire.
- Dispose of any yard or household waste on the premises.
- Drive or park any motor vehicles, including two and three wheeled motor powered cycles, motor powered farm equipment and off-road vehicles of any type, except in roads and parking areas designated for the public.
- Allow their pets to run without leash or restraint, or fail to remove pet waste.
